

Pupil Premium

In the financial year 2014-15 the school received £61,286 pupil premium.

This was spent upon:

- targeted support for literacy and numeracy;
- targeted support for therapeutic interventions
- work related learning experiences for hard to reach pupils at KS4
- enriching the curriculum eg educational visits
- attendance officer
